


Read&Write for Mac

Tool	Icon	How it works
Text to Speech		<p>Reads text aloud in Word docs, on the web and more, with dual color highlighting and natural-sounding voices.</p> <p>Highlight or place your cursor in front of some text, and click the Play button. Use additional controls to rewind, fast forward, pause and stop speech playback.</p>
Highlights & Erase Highlights		<p>Allows users to highlight and color code sections of text on a page, to facilitate summarizing, categorizing and higher order skills.</p> <p>Erase highlights from a page when you are done with them, by selecting highlights and clicking the Erase icon.</p>
Prediction		<p>Provides word suggestions as you type. Develops writing skills and helps construct error-free sentences more easily.</p> <p>Use the Play button on the Read&Write toolbar to hear a word suggestion read aloud. Double-click on a word to insert.</p>
Screenshot Reader		<p>Converts inaccessible text to accessible text through OCR.</p> <p>Click the icon and then drag your mouse to draw a rectangle around any inaccessible text, to OCR it on demand.</p>
Spell Check		<p>Click this button to perform a Spell Check on a document. Use the Play button on the Read&Write toolbar to hear word suggestions and dictionary definitions read aloud.</p>
Dictionary		<p>Provides definitions to improve comprehension and writing.</p> <p>Highlight a word and click the Dictionary icon. Click on a definition and click the Play button on the Read&Write toolbar to hear read aloud.</p>

<p>Similar Word Checker</p>		<p>Click this button to identify homophones and confusable words. Click the Play button on the Read&Write toolbar to hear definitions read aloud.</p>
<p>PDF Reader</p>		<p>Click this button and select a PDF to open in the PDF Reader. Use the Click to Speak icon to read your document, or use the other Read&Write tools like Dictionary and Picture Dictionary on the text.</p>
<p>Picture Dictionary</p>		<p>Displays images from Widgeit® Symbols to help support fluency and understanding.</p>
<p>Verb Checker</p>		<p>Shows a verb table with conjugation options for a selected verb. Click Play to hear them read aloud and click the Replace button to add the selected verb into your document.</p>
<p>Scanning</p>		<p>Scan a paper document and convert it to accessible PDF or Word format, or OCR an existing PDF to make it accessible.</p>
<p>Screen Masking</p>		<p>Tints or masks section of your screen, or provides a spotlight that follows your mouse pointer. Helps with improving focus.</p>
<p>Vocabulary List</p>		<p>Builds vocabulary lists in a Word doc, including selected words, dictionary definitions, images from Widgeit Symbols, and an editable notes column. Use colored highlighters to select words, then click icon to generate vocabulary list in a new Word doc.</p>
<p>Audio Maker</p>		<p>Select a piece of text then click this button to convert the text into an audio file e.g. mp3.</p>
<p>Daisy Reader</p>		<p>Opens Daisy books saved on your computer, and uses Text to Speech to read them.</p>
<p>Web Search</p>		<p>Helps with research by doing a web search for relevant information on a topic.</p>

<p>Calculator</p>		<p>Click this button to launch your Mac calculator.</p>
<p>Research Folder</p>		<p>Select information you wish to store from a website then click this button, and choose "Add Fact". The fact and website address are saved.</p>
<p>Translator</p>		<p>Translates single words and larger selections of text into multiple languages.</p>
<p>Collect Highlights</p>		<p>Collects your highlights into a new Word doc. Adjust collection and bibliography settings in the Read&Write settings menu, under the Highlights section.</p>
